





Matching Process



- Tailored Matching: Students are matched with mentors based on their major, goals, and specific preferences outlined in their application.
- Network-Driven Support: If a student's application doesn't align with a currently available Sparks Mentor, we actively
 seek a mentor within the network of the founder, Advisory Board, or existing mentors to find and onboard a suitable
 match.
- Proposed Matches: When a potential match is identified, the student's profile is presented to the mentor for approval before moving forward.
- Mentorship Start: Once the mentor accepts the match, both the student and mentor receive an acceptance notification. The student's preferred start date, as indicated in their application, will be confirmed to initiate the mentorship.

Mentorship Foundation



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- Student-Driven Goals: The mentorship is centered around the goals that each student outlines in their application. These
 goals are further refined during the first two meetings to ensure alignment with their aspirations.
- Standardized Framework: The program uses a set of 40+ Mentorship Standards that act as a guideline. Mentors and students review these standards together to decide which are most relevant and valuable for their specific mentorship journey.
- Customized Approach: While we provide a structured foundation, the mentorship is flexible, allowing each studentmentor pair to focus on the areas that matter most to the student's personal and professional growth.



Student Responsibilities



- Set Your Goals: Take the lead in defining your mentorship objectives and choosing your personal standards.
- Plan Meetings: Collaborate with your mentor to establish clear objectives for each meeting.
- Track Progress: Regularly assess your development with your mentor and adjust as needed.
- Stay Engaged: Work on your goals and standards between meetings to the best of your ability.
- Prepare in Advance: Send your mentor an agenda at least 3 days before your next meeting.






The Mentorship Process




- The student drives the mentorship process by setting goals, while the mentor offers perspective, knowledge, and resources to help them achieve those goals.
- The mentorship includes a monthly 60min mentoring session over the course of one year.



What Happens Next?




- Application Review: Each submission is carefully reviewed.
- Application Acceptance: Qualified applications are approved and moved forward to the next stage of the process.
- Mentor Matching: Students are paired with mentors based on their interests, goals, and availability.
- Matching Communication: Students receive notification about their match.
- Onboarding Scheduling: Agreement is reached on date for onboarding for student and mentor (sessions 2x month).
- Onboarding: Students and new mentors learn about program and available resources.
- First Meeting: Students connect with their assigned mentor to refine goals and begin their mentorship journey.




How to Apply



- Select Application: Choose Application from the Student menu
- Create Site Account: Fill out the site membership Create Account form (or chose Log In if you have an account already). You will receive a confirmation code via email (check your junk folder). If you have an account and are already logged-in, you will be taken straight to application.
- Apply: You will be transferred to the application for completion once you have created your account and provided the confirmation code.



We've recently introduced a Student Waiver to protect everyone as the program grows. This helps us continue supporting students long-term.
